



The City is monitoring for mosquitoes. Spraying of the entire city will begin two nights a week, Tuesday and Thursday evenings, to try to control mosquitoes. We will cut back on spraying when the current infestation is under control. If the weather does not permit, then spraying will be done the following Wednesday or Friday evening. MosquitoMist (organophosphate, Chlorpyrifos) will be used. Spraying is being done late in the evening. The city is treating standing water in our parks with a larvacide to prevent mosquitoes from hatching in them.

If you are outside, you may want to wear long sleeves and slacks. Spray yourself with a mosquito repellent containing DEET or whatever you prefer. You can reduce the mosquito habitat around your home by mowing, cutting weeds, spraying shrubs and around property, and emptying standing water daily. If you have allergies to these chemicals, please submit in writing.
