CITY OF LITTLEFIELD TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

The City of Littlefield will hold a public hearing at Littlefield City Hall, 301 Xit Dr., Littlefield, TX 79339, on Tuesday, November 16, 2019 at 5:30pm in regards to the 2017 Texas Community Development Block Grant Program that has recently been completed for the City of Littlefield.

This public hearing is being held to review the outcome of the 2017 Texas Community Development Block Grant Program for sewer and water improvements for the City of Littlefield. The sewer improvements consisted of the installation of two (2) aerators, improvements to six (6) SCADA systems, electrical improvements, and all associated appurtenances. Construction for this portion of the project took place at the Waste Water Treatment Plant located at the intersection of FM 54 and County Road 217, lift station

located at the intersection of FM 54 and County Road 217, lift station located at West 6th Street and South Ripley Avenue, lift station located on South Sunset Avenue, the main lift station located at FM 54 and County Road 213, lift station located at MLK Boulevard and Texas Avenue, and lift station located at Barton Avenue and West 1st Street.

The water improvements consisted of the installation of two (2) SCADA systems, and all associated appurtenances. Construction for this portion of the project took place at the elevated storage tank located at the intersection of West 1st Street and Delano Avenue and at an elevated storage tank located at South Sunset Avenue.

La construcción de esta parte del proyecto se llevó a cabo en la planta de tratamiento de aguas residuales ubicada en la intersección de FM 54 y County Road 217, estación de ascensor ubicada en la autopista 84 y South Brownlee Street, estación de ascensor ubicada en West^{6th} Street y South Ripley Avenue, estación de ascensor ubicada en South Sunset Avenue, la estación principal de ascensores ubicada en FM 54 y County Road 213, estación de ascensor ubicada en MLK Boulevard y Texas, y estación de ascensor ubicada en Barton Avenue y West^{1st}.

Las mejoras en el agua consistieron en la instalación de dos (2) sistemas SCADA, y todos los accesorios asociados. La construcción de esta parte del proyecto tuvo lugar en el tanque de almacenamiento elevado ubicado en la intersección de West 1st Street y Delano Avenue y en un tanque de almacenamiento elevado ubicado en South Sunset Avenue.
