ORDINANCE NO. 2026-0127-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLEFIELD, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF HALL AVENUE CAMPGROUNDS; PROVIDING RULES FOR THE WAYLON JENNINGS RV PARK NORTH AND SOUTH SECTIONS OF THE CAMPGROUND; ESTABLISHING TIME LIMITS, FEES, AND RESTRICTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Littlefield owns and operates public campground facilities located along Hall Avenue, known as Waylon Jennings Campground, which includes the North and South RV Park Sections; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to establish reasonable rules and regulations governing the use of these public campgrounds to ensure safety, sanitation, and equitable use by all visitors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLEFIELD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

- **Waylon Jennings Campground** means the public camping areas located on Hall Avenue, including the North and South RV Park Sections.
 - **RV (Recreational Vehicle)** means a self-contained travel trailer, motorhome, or camper designed for temporary living accommodations.
 - **Visitor** means any person using or occupying a campsite within the Hall Avenue Campgrounds.
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SECTION 2. WAYLON JENNINGS NORTH SECTION CAMPGROUND

1. The North Section Campground is designated as a **limited hookup campground**, offering **electricity and water only**.
 2. **No sewer hookups** are provided in this section.
 3. Use of this section is **free of charge**, and visitors may **leave voluntary donations** to assist with maintenance.
 4. Visitors are permitted to stay for a **maximum of five (5) consecutive 24-hour periods**.
 5. After the five-day limit, the visitor must vacate the premises for at least **seven (7) days** before returning.
 6. **No long-term stays** are permitted in this section.
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SECTION 3. WAYLON JENNINGS SOUTH SECTION CAMPGROUND

1. The South Section Campground provides **electricity, water, and sewer hookups**.
 2. Visitors may stay up to **ten (10) consecutive 24-hour periods** within a 30-day period at a rate of **\$30.00 per day**.
 3. **Ten days is the maximum stay permitted** within any 30-day period.
 4. Visitors who exceed the maximum stay will be required to vacate the premises and may be subject to citation or towing at their expense.
 5. Reservations and Payments can be made at city hall or online as available.
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SECTION 4. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES AND STRUCTURES

1. **No fencing, skirting, decks, sheds, or other temporary or permanent structures** are allowed.
2. **No tents** of any kind are permitted in either section of the campground.
3. **No open flames or burn pits** are allowed.
4. Campfires are prohibited unless contained within City-provided or approved fire receptacles.
5. **All pets** must be leashed and under control at all times in accordance with city ordinance [§ 2.01.008 Care and control of dogs](#). Visitors may use the *dog park* but are encouraged to clean up after their pets.
6. **No Parking** on grass areas or where prohibited.

SECTION 5. COMMUNITY EVENTS

In the event of a **community event, festival, or city function**, all visitors may be required to **temporarily vacate, relocate, or register** with the City of Littlefield as directed. The City shall provide reasonable notice of such requirements whenever possible.

SECTION 6. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES

1. Violations of this ordinance shall be subject to a **fine not to exceed \$500 per offense**.
 2. Each day a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
 3. The City Manager, Police Department, and authorized City personnel shall have authority to enforce this ordinance, including removal of noncompliant campers or vehicles.
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SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY

If any section, clause, or provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 8. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
