Basic Information

Section 552.108(c) of the Public Information Act provides that basic information about an arrested person, an arrest, or a crime is not excepted from required public disclosure. The kinds of basic information not excepted from disclosure by section 552.108 are those that were deemed public in *Houston Chronicle Publishing Co. v. City of Houston* and catalogued in Open Records Decision No. 127 (1976). Basic information is information that ordinarily appears on the first page of an offense report and in other records of law enforcement agencies relating to arrest such as:

- (a) the name, age, address, race, sex, occupation, alias, and physical condition of the arrested person;
- (b) the date and time of the arrest;
- (c) the offense charged and the court in which it is filed;
- (d) the details of the arrest;
- (e) booking information;
- (f) the notation of any release or transfer;
- (g) bonding information;
- (h) the location of the crime;
- (i) the identification and description of the complainant;
- (j) the premises involved;
- (k) the time of occurrence of the crime;
- (l) the property involved, if any;
- (m) the vehicles involved, if any;
- (n) a description of the weather;
- (o) a detailed description of the offense; and
- (p) the names of the arresting and investigating officers.

Generally, the identity of the victim or complainant may not be withheld from disclosure under Section 552.108. However, information tending to identify victims of serious sexual offenses must be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to section 552.101 because such information is protected by common-law privacy.
